

*Testimony of Pastor Pat Kaveny,
a prophet of the Lord*

God asked me four questions:

“What would it be like
if we let our children
grow up on their own
with no guidance
or sense of God?”

“What would it be like
if *their* children grew up
with no guidance
or sense of God?”

“What would it be like
if a godless government
became the parents
of these children?”

“Where would
these children be
after 40 years?”

Then the Spirit of God gave me this answer . . .

“We are there now...”

Our Father in Heaven led me to many horrific statistics which grieve Him concerning our parental stewardship of *His* children in America:

During the 12 months before the survey, 11.3% of students nationwide had made a plan about how they would attempt suicide

Nationwide, 35.5% of students had been in a physical fight one or more times during the 12 months before the survey

Nationwide, 5.9% of students had carried a weapon (e.g., a gun, knife, or club) on school property on at least 1 day during the 30 days before the survey

Nationwide, 26.0% of students had had five or more drinks of alcohol in a row (i.e., within a couple of hours) on at least 1 day during the 30 days before the survey

Nationwide, 7.8% of students had been physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did not want to

Nationwide, 35.0% of students had had sexual intercourse with at least one person during the 3 months before the survey

•63% of youth suicides are from fatherless homes. (U. S. D.H.H.S. Bureau of the Census)

•90% of all homeless and runaway children are from fatherless homes.

•85% of all children that exhibit behavioral disorders come from fatherless homes.

•80% of rapists motivated with displaced anger come from fatherless homes.

•71% of all high school dropouts come from fatherless homes.

•70% of juveniles in state operated institutions come from fatherless homes

•85% of all youths sitting in prisons grew up in a fatherless home.

•Nearly 2 of every 5 children in America do not live with their fathers.

Christian Believers by Generation (all denominations)

In a survey of 6000 people, with 1300-1500 people in each of the generations, the following percentages of each generation identified themselves as Christian.

GI and Silent generations - born before 1926, and 1927-45, respectively - **65% Christian**

Baby Boom - born 1946-64 - **35% Christian**

Gen X (baby bust) - born 1965-76 - **15% Christian**

Older Bridgers (age 17+) - born 1976-81 - **4% Christian**
