

# Introduction to “The Cry”

I have not been called to be a prophet of doom, but to be a representative of God, who by God’s will is now living in this perilous time today . . . when the decisions of man will cause outcomes that affect many—either good or bad.

Although there are often long seasons of our lives when things seem as if they will continue as they have been, there always comes a time which I call a “defining moment.” If we miss these “defining moments” and fail to respond, the outcome may be bad. Of course, we always eventually reap what has been sown (good or bad).

Such “defining moments” frequently occur when our circumstances have taken us down to the wire and now our decision or action becomes urgent. Or, if we’re on a battlefield, when the enemy is about to attempt something, we must respond or he will destroy what we do not defend. In the Bible we see many “defining moments” when an outcome is at hand...good or bad, blessing or curse.

In such times I have seen two attitudes. One leads to the way of danger and destruction, the other to safety and into blessing. To avoid the wrong course it is necessary, before we hear the word of our Lord, that we be willing to first deal with a wrong attitude in our own heart. The wrong attitude will often deceive us. Let me give an example: Because we all want to feel safe and live in comfort, many in the name of the Lord will say everything is OK, nothing will happen, do not be concerned, when actually we are at a “defining moment.” In these moments we need to respond to God, not to that which may look safe or comfortable in our own eyes. We need to be alert to what is really going on and ask God for instruction. Often, what some may call a “fear message,” is really a merciful warning message for us to be watchful and responsive to God. There is a significant difference between fear and wise concern or soberness.

*And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;*

*Men’s hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.*

*And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.*

*And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.*

*And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees;*

*When they now shoot forth, ye see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand.*

*So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand.*

*Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled. Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.*

*And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.*

*For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.*

*Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.*

—the words of Jesus from Luke 21:25-36

Many today are teaching that we are to reject any message that creates discomfort—they describe discomfort as fear. They say the Holy Spirit only brings exhortation, edification, and comfort. This is only part of a truth. Although the Holy Spirit operates in this realm, this is not the only way that the Spirit of God operates in the New Testament. This same loving God corrects, warns, and, yes, even judges. Many today have created their own view of the Holy Spirit that is not consistent with the Word of God. They have taken only the parts they want and have created a false Holy Spirit. This Spirit they have created only comforts and does not correct, or warn. These are false prophets.

The real prophets speak the counsel of heaven, whether that is comfort, correction, or even judgment. You see, when we are warned away from danger or corrected, and take corrective action, then we do not fall into judgment. The Bible has warned God's people many times, bringing them to certain "defining moments." God's Word teaches His people to be awake, watchful, and sober. It teaches that if we pay heed, then we will be calm, walking in victory, and God's peace. Those that are awake will know God's counsel, make wise decisions, and be secure. Those who deny anything is wrong and just say "peace, peace," when the Lord has not spoken that, will be in trouble.

When Ezekiel prophesied to Israel they were coming to a "defining moment." They had been away from God for some time, and their "defining moment" was soon to arrive. The prophet of God warned them to turn and avoid disaster and captivity. The false prophets told them not to worry; that everything is fine; there is no need for any response or concern. They followed these false prophets into a time of destruction that could have been avoided.

*And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,*

*Son of man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy, and say thou unto them that prophesy out of their own hearts, Hear ye the word of the LORD;*

*Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!*

*O Israel, thy prophets are like the foxes in the deserts.*

*Ye have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD.*

*They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word.*

*Have ye not seen a vain vision, and have ye not spoken a lying divination, whereas ye say, The LORD saith it; albeit I have not spoken?*

*Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I am against you, saith the Lord GOD.*

*And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.*

*Because, even because they have seduced my people, saying, Peace; and there was no peace; and one built up a wall, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered mortar:*

—Ezekiel 13:1-10

Now here's the counsel of the Apostle Paul in the New Testament. Does it sound familiar?

*But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.*

*For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.*

*But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.*

*Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.*

*Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.*

—1 Thessalonians 5:1-6

Dear reader, when God's warning comes, you will respond one way or another. You may try to comfort yourself, saying everything will be OK, I need not be concerned. You may even go as far as to rebuke any word that makes you feel uncomfortable, whether from God or not. We need to let the Spirit of God discern truth for us rather than a deceitful, wicked heart, because truth is only condemning when we fail to receive it.

Before you read any of what has been written concerning "The Cry," please take the time to let the Holy Spirit reveal those things in your heart that would keep you from receiving the urgency of the times we are now in. Ask the Holy Spirit to wake you up. Ask the Holy Spirit to confirm the truth of the "defining moment" you are facing. Ask God to reveal to you what he wants you to do next, then OBEY. If you do I promise you will have peace and God will receive the glory.

# “The Cry”

*Testimony of Pastor Patrick Kaveny, a prophet of the Lord*

One night, in May, 2007, when I was driving home I approached the road off the Interstate that I turn on to go home. All of a sudden I felt the presence of the Lord and I heard the voice of the Lord and He said, “You go on. You just continue to drive.” So, in obedience I did that and continued to drive. I felt the presence of the Lord like I have never felt before in my life. I heard Him say, “I am about to show you what I have created you for from the foundation of the earth. I am about to show you why I have created you for such a time as this.”

I drove down the highway for a little bit to an area called Cahokia, which is east of the Saint Louis metropolitan area. He said “turn” and I turned. He showed me a street and I went down it. He showed me a house and said “stop.” I stopped and I listened. And all of a sudden, I heard a cry (by the Spirit) come out of this home. I began to know this home. I’ve heard words of wisdom, words of knowledge, I’ve had dreams and I’ve had visions and I’ve had God move on me in mighty ways and even personalize things but what I just experienced I never have had happen in my entire life. I mean to tell you, there was a young African-American girl in this home and I knew her (by the Spirit of God) as if I was her. I knew her life as if I was her. I knew that she’d been molested time and time again by a father that she actually loved. I knew this father, that she actually loved, had beaten her mother severely and he had left. And I heard her cries and I felt her pain and I was so moved. It was as if I couldn’t even take (the pain of) what I just felt. There was so much pain in this girl’s heart, yet the Lord said “move and drive.” And I did.

And the whole time that I was driving I never quit feeling the pain of that girl nor hearing her cry. I came to another home and the Lord said “stop.” I saw (by the Spirit of God) a young man in this home and his father was in the home. He was a young man about seventeen years old, with blond hair and his father was so abusive and so

violent to this young man...yelling and screaming and just constantly tearing this young man down to the point that this young man was in so much pain. He was desiring love from his father, desiring a father that would be what God had put in him to be and all he could do was cry. And the cry of this young man was anger, but it was yet a cry. It was anger as a spirit of murder like you would have seen on the young man at the Virginia Tech shooting tragedy.

The Lord said "drive." And I drove again. I drove for over two and a half hours around this Metro East Saint Louis area. During this time I would hear a cry and it was very individual. It was as if I was that person. But every cry I heard never went away. Pretty soon I began to hear cry, after cry, after cry, after cry, after cry, to the point that I was just weeping and said "Lord, I can't take it. Oh God, I can't take anymore." I was in the area of Granite City where the area abortion clinic was at. I was coming up a road called Chain of Rocks road and I pulled into a church parking lot. And I literally pulled over and said "God, I cannot drive any more, I can't take any more of this. God, what are you trying to show me?"

I nearly collapsed out the door of the van. I heard the Lord saying, "Now, do you hear this?" I'd never heard anything like that before in my life. He said "Do you hear this?" And I said "Yes, Lord, I hear it" He said "This is the cry of the fatherless." He said, "This cry is only a small bit of what I hear just in your area, let alone in your nation. These cries, my son, come before me day and night."

The Lord continued, "These are my destinies, these are my creations, these are my heritage, and the nation has forgotten them and abandoned them."

Later, He gave me the following verses from Exodus 22:22-24:

*Ye shall not afflict any widow,  
or fatherless child.  
If thou afflict them in any wise,  
and they cry at all unto me,  
I will surely hear their cry;  
And my wrath shall wax hot,  
and I will kill you with the sword;  
and your wives shall be widows,  
and your children fatherless.*

# “The Warnings”

*Note to readers from Pastor Pat:*

*I urge you to re-read “The Cry,” because without that message you will not be able to hear the heart of the Lord in what you are about to read. There is an order in which God is laying this out.*

*When we read the book of Revelation we will see messages that God gives to different churches, saying “I have this against you.” There may be many other things but there is one specific thing which is His main thing that He has against each of them. Please read “The Cry” to understand that ONE specific thing pertaining to our nation. I really believe what I am about to share with you is not just an urgent warning but I believe it is THE urgent warning to the people of the United States of America.*

## **“Warning #1” May of 2007**

On that night, after I heard the cry and after I heard the Lord ask “Do you hear this?” I heard Him say:

“In two years I am going to visit (the people of) this nation to see what they have done with those cries, to see how they have responded to those cries, and I will visit them according to their response.”

## **“Warning #2” January of 2008**

I was on the last week of a 21-day fast when I heard a sound like a hammer tapping on wood. The sound was not like a carpenter building a home, but like a judge’s gavel. I inquired of the Lord as to what this was. He said these are the verdicts that have been given in heaven. Then he gave me a vision of the scales of justice.

Again I inquired of the Lord what this meant. He proceeded to tell me that both the nation and individuals have been in the season of accounting for several years (Note: In 1996, the Lord had given me a word about our nation entering into this season) and now verdicts

were given as to our stewardship (over the things given to us). I could sense by the Spirit that we had come out of a season where some were now found guilty and lacking and some were found to be good stewards and would receive rewards. All I could do was to examine myself and say "Lord, have mercy on me."

The Lord explained to me how this was similar to a court trial held on earth. First, the judge examines the evidence. After examining the evidence, the judge renders a verdict. The Lord said that for several years He had been watching us to see what we had done with what He had freely given us. He had been examining the condition of our hearts and our stewardship over what we had done with what He had given us, especially His heritage. What I heard that day were the verdicts being handed down to individuals, churches, and our nation. Once again I was struck with reverential fear. I could only say, "Lord, be merciful to me." He gave me no answer as to if I had been found guilty or faithful.

The only one thing He did tell me was the United States of America had been found guilty and responsible for its poor spiritual stewardship of and the condition of this generation. He told me the nation as a whole had His blessing removed, but His blessing would now be shifted to households (families). For years, even non-believers could live in peace under His blessing which had been upon this nation, but now that blessing had been lifted. The blessing would still be given, however, it would now only be upon households (families who were living selflessly for Him with the physical and spiritual resources He had given them).

He told me the time we're in now is a time when His sentencing had not yet been decided. This period of two years after I had been allowed to hear the cry of the fatherless in the nation is a time that He was yet willing to give mercy to those found guilty...*if* they would respond with tender hearts and repentance.

He then started to give me many scriptures concerning the blessing of faithful fathers and faithful stewards over their households and how He'll be looking for that when He visits us.

Words of Jesus from Matthew 24:43-51:

*But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.*

*Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.*

*Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?*

*Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.*

*Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.*

*But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;*

*And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;*

*The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,*

*And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.*

### **"Warning #3" May of 2008**

The Lord gave me a dream. In this dream I was standing on a city sidewalk of a typical city in the United States. I was standing between a government office building and the street. On the street was a hearse, it was an older hearse. A hearse is a picture of death. This older hearse had some dirt on it, the trim was hanging off of it, and it just needed to be cleaned up. The back door was open. I thought some poor person was going to a burial in this thing and they deserved more than this so I began to wipe the dirt off and put the trim back on.

The engine was running. Considering where we were at, I thought the hearse might get stolen, so I thought I better stay and guard it. When the mortician (revealed to me as a government worker) came out of the office building, the Lord said "This building is a picture of the world system." The mortician was carrying a dead body.

And this dead body was covered up to the top of the head, but the head was bald. And the body was put in the hearse. The Lord said, "That hearse that you have been polishing, that hearse that you have been trying to hold up, is a picture of the religious system in the United States of America. It has tried to be polished and held together, but it only leads to death." He said "People are being taken out of the world system and being put into that. And there is the condition of things."

Then, the mortician started to plug something connected to a machine into the head of this bald-headed body and it began to pump what seemed to be embalming fluid into the body. It was almost like this was a finality before taking the body to a grave to be buried. But, all of a sudden, the hand of the Lord intervened and the machine was shut off. I perceived that was the mercy of God.

After that happened I was translated to a room. In that room I saw the body being brought in. I perceived the room was where the morticians prepare the body for a funeral. But this time the body was uncovered. And the frame of the body was that of a baby, the head was that of an older man, and the body was all fleshy and blubber. I asked the Lord "What is this?" and He said "This is the picture of three generations. The picture of the Boomers, the

Generation-Xers and the Bridgers (those between the ages of 14 - 31). The Lord showed me this bald head was a picture of the boomer generation or the grandparents who had lost their covering (by God). The lack of hair was symbolic of lost covering. The blubber is the Generation-Xers who have become fat in the world, and the frame is that of the Bridgers or infants who were supposed to be parented by the other two generations.

The morticians began to take this body and finalize the work before the funeral. They started to plug the machine back into the head, but all of a sudden, when they tried to do that, this body sat up straight and gave the most blood-curdling cry I have ever heard in my entire life. And it was the cry of an infant. It was such a horrible cry of depravation and horror that I can't even describe it with words. I said, "Lord, what is this?" And He said "It is the picture of the last awakening and this is the condition that it will be in."

Well, the last thing that I saw in this dream was the two morticians debating. One was saying "It's in such terrible condition, should we kill it and just go on with the funeral? Nobody will even know. Or should we let it live?" That was the end of the dream.

When I woke up, the Lord began to give me the interpretation of the dream. He said "That is where you are at right now with the decision if it will live or if it will die."

#### **"Warning #4" August 29, 2008**

On this evening I met with Jon. Both of us sensed God's urgency in arranging this meeting. As we were talking and praying about our nation's response to "The Cry," the Lord gave me this word: "Now it is a time of passover (for households in America). Get in this place. It is life or death."

## **"Warning #5" September 17, 2008**

This afternoon, as Jon and I were praying, the Spirit of the Lord brought this message:

"This will be the final warning for America, but it will be a merciful warning. It will be a warning that they cannot deny they have heard over and over and over and over and over and over and over again. It will be a warning where they cannot deny they have been given mercy over and over and over and over again. It will be such a warning that they cannot deny they have heard. They can't deny that I have reached out to them. Life or death is in what is written and what is heard. If they will respond to me with tender hearts and a full repentance, they will receive revival, restoration, healing and I will receive the glory. But if they turn a deaf ear to me then they will reap what they have sown. And just as they have abandoned my heritage, so will they be abandoned. How will they respond? How will they respond? How will they respond?"

"Nine months from the time this word is given there will be a cry heard in the land and it will be everywhere. And it will be just as the child woke up in that dream...woke up screaming in horror, in agony, in fear. And just as they (the morticians) looked at each other and said "Shall it live or shall it die," in nine months that cry will be heard and I will visit this nation according to how they respond to that cry. Will they let it live or will they choose death? And I say to you: I set before you life and death, the blessing or the curse. I've made it plain. Choose life. Choose life. Choose...I give you a choice...life."

*Note to readers from Pastor Pat:*

*This is a very sobering realization. We all have grown accustomed to living in a nation blessed by God...a nation protected, prospered, and favored by God. However, when January 16, 2008, arrived (see Warning #2), that understanding all changed for me. God revealed to me on that date that His blessing had shifted off of the nation and onto the individual households (families) who were raising up His heritage.*

*Now the Lord wants us to prepare our households according to His word...*

## **“Prepare your household”      December 13, 2008**

The Lord began to minister to me about the covering and the blessing in His Word about households. He showed me Noah’s house, Lot’s house, Jacob’s house, Moses’ house, and many other households in the word of God. These families were protected, provided for, and favored by God even in very perilous times. His question to me (and to all families):

What condition is your household in?

I sensed that God, in His mercy, is giving us a brief time to prepare our households.

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
